Blast from the past....

Award gives Steve a season's best result

STEVE Stringer produced his best result of the season when with Martin Kiernan he finished sixth overall and won the class for cars up to 1600 cc on last week-end's Kettering Stages.

The event was organized by Wickford Automobile Club and the Rainham pair took their Team Drive-In Escort 1600 to its best result over 12 varied stages in Essex, with the stages mainly composed of stubble fields, concrete farm roads, grassy sea walls and even an old horse racetrack.

Another local man to put in a creditable performance was Chris Browne, who with wife, Nicki, took his Talbot Sunbeam to 18th place overall against some very experienced Essex crews.

His main problem on the day was his tyre supply. He had to use standard road tyres on loose surfaces, while on the concrete surface suited to that particular brand, he took two seconds off Stringer and showed that with the correct tyres he could be quite a force.

Rainham co-driver Brian Parker took the passenger seat of Peter Lee's Escort 1600, but they suffered from a battery lead failure on one stage and Parker had to complete it sitting in the boot making the vital connection.

This problem cost them two minutes in penalties and they finally finished 24th overall.

Rainham's other representative was Colin Skinner, who, with wife, Sue, took his Escort 1300 round to 27th overall, despite a couple of minor problems and a few lurid spins!

Unluckiest person of the day had to be Mike Hands, because the Rainham driver saw his championship lead disappear when he was excluded from second place in his Escort due to a navigational error by Mike Dawson.

It was an error which, it must be said, was largely due to the organizers' lack of clarity in their route instructions. And that was something which saw quite a few crews disqualified needlessly.

Hands will make another attempt to regain his South East championship lead this week-end when he competes in the Motor Mania Stages Rally, to be held in the same area.

Hopefully, last week-end's upset will not affect his excellent co-driver as they look for yet another top placing against crews with equipment more expensive and powerful than themselves.

Colin and Sue Skinner also make the trip to Essex in search of more experience and will hope to do battle with the powerful Hillman Imps in their comparatively low-powered Escort 1300.

Making plans to visit Belgium next month is Ray Smith, who is the British crew's co-ordinator for the Oloop von Vlaanderen, or the

Tour of Flanders International Rally.

Ray, an acknowledged farmac expert, finished an exceptional 11th last year and will be hoping to emulate this feat in his newly acquired and built Hillman Avenger — his last motor having had an unscheduled meeting with a wild bear on an event in Belgium earlier in the year.

Co-driver from the Flanders event will be Martin Kiernan, who has been to the continent quite a few times and has a fair bit of experience in Belgian conditions.

Some assistance with tyres is coming from Ray Holding, at Tyr-ewell in Gillingham.

Other local crews known to be making the trip are Kevin Haselden and Liz Jenner in the Hazleden Group Sunbeam and Bob Ward and John King in Bob's newly acquired Fiat 127 Sport.

More details will come nearer the time of the event.
